



Commitment Policy for Senior Members

Hinckley Ladies Netball Club wishes Netball to be an enjoyable and positive experience for all its members. For this reason, we require all members to read and agree to this policy as part of the club's registration process.

The Commitment Policy

Players must communicate attendance to their captain using the schedule option on Heja at their earliest opportunity. A direct message should be sent to their Captain in advance of the training session/match/event, should there be a late change. Registers are taken at every training session and match, and this register will be used to gauge attendance and commitment levels.

Commitment Expectations for Senior Players

As a senior player at Hinckley Ladies Netball Club, the club require a level of commitment from yourself to be able to provide a positive experience for you and others whilst being a member of HLNC.

Heja

- I will make sure Heja is checked regularly, and app notifications are on.
- I will update the Heja schedule as soon as I can, ensuring I give plenty of notice regarding my availability for training sessions (and fixtures).
- I will communicate any changes to attendance with my Captain using Heja as soon as I am aware of a change (or potential change) to my availability.

WhatsApp

- I will check the group chat regularly to ensure I don't miss key information.
- I recognise these chats are used as a communication tool from Committee Members to the wider club, I will respond promptly to my captains when questions are asked in the chat.

Payments

- I will pay all fees in a timely manner and communicate with the treasurer/chair/vice chair if I'm unable to make payment.
- I will make other ad hoc payments (e.g., events) promptly and communicate with the treasurer/chair/vice chair if I'm unable to make payment.

General Commitments

- I will attend training (and fixtures) each week, even in poor weather.
- I will support my captain by communicating any questions or issues I have.
- I understand that the club's Coaches spend lots of their time planning and preparing sessions, and I will make sure to conduct myself appropriately.
